Inmate Death – Christopher Rogers

6/8/2020 (Anchorage) – On Saturday, June 6, 2020 at 1415 hours, inmate Christopher Rogers, 41, was pronounced dead at Seward Providence Medical Center.

Next of kin have been notified.

Rogers has been in DOC custody since December 3, 2007, serving a 498 year sentence for one count of Murder 1, one count of Attempted Murder 1, two counts of Murder 2, two counts of Assault 1, one count of Vehicle Theft 1, one count of Theft 2, one count of Cruelty to Animals and two counts of Violating Conditions of Release.

His death is the fourth in DOC custody this year.

Every prisoner death is reviewed by the Alaska State Troopers and the Medical Examiner's Office. Department records are generally not subject to release because they contain confidential medical, security and personnel information.
