Inmate Death - Zenon Habros

6/10/2020 (Anchorage) – On June 9, 2020, inmate Zenon Habros, 61, was pronounced dead at Anvil Mountain Correctional Center in Nome.

Habros was found unresponsive in his cell at 1717 hours. Correctional Officers and medical staff immediately began performing life-saving measures until EMS arrived on scene. EMS pronounced Mr. Habros dead at 1735 hours.

Habros has been in DOC custody on 5/26/2020. He was an unsentenced inmate charged with Kidnapping, Sexual Abuse of a Minor 1, two counts of Sexual Abuse of a Minor 2, and Assault 4.

His death is the fifth in DOC custody this year. Next of kin have been notified. No foul play is suspected.

Every prisoner death is reviewed by the Alaska State Troopers and the Medical Examiner's Office. Department records are generally not subject to release because they contain confidential medical, security and personnel information.
