*People are considered fully vaccinated for COVID-19 at least two weeks after they have received the second dose of a two-dose series (Moderna or Pfizer) OR at least two weeks after receiving a single dose vaccine (Johnson & Johnson).

Anyone entering this facility must wear a mask covering their nose and mouth and observe strict social distancing. No physical contact is allowed.
