REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

CURRENT OFFENSE DESCRIPTION:
 Include a brief synopsis of the current offense to give a general idea of the circumstances involved

CASE PLAN SUMMATION:
 Include historical or current factors related to the offender criminogenic needs (LSI) and conditions of supervision. Include areas such as: education, social/family, substance abuse, mental health, and general attitude.

***Example:** High risk area involved substance abuse (cocaine); history regarding use since age 21; use daily up to age 25; prior treatment in inpatient (2x); relapsed. Offender basically untreated at this point and time. Immediate need to address substance abuse; referral made to treatment program.*

SUPERVISION STRATEGY:
 Summary strategy on how case supervision will assist with criminogenic needs of the individual and conditions of probation per the court or parole board.

*Include summation of prior periods of supervision; current barriers to success; and goals to address these behaviors. **Example:** If education is a barrier, how will we address this need through supervision strategies?*

***Goal:** Defendant will obtain their GED; referral made to adult literacy program; per condition #103. Defendant set goal at 90 days for testing and attainment. ~~PO assisted in getting books free of charge due to defendant's finances.~~*

VIOLATIONS IN ABEYANCE:

CASE PLAN UPDATE:

To be utilized when circumstances warrant a need for re-evaluation either through PO discretion or policy. NOTE: ***A petition to revoke or parole violation report warrants re-evaluation as does significant changes in the individuals life either positive or negative. Significant changes include: criminal conviction, change in marital status, death in immediate family, extended unemployment (6 months)
