Authority

In accordance with 22 AAC 05.155, the Department will maintain a manual composed of policies and procedures established by the Commissioner to interpret and implement relevant sections of the Alaska Statutes and 22 AAC.

AS 33.36.110

Purpose

To establish uniform procedures within the Department for Interstate Compact Administration.

Application

All employees.

Policy

- A. The Commissioner will designate an employee of the department to be the Deputy Compact Administrator.
- B. The Deputy Compact Administrator shall assist and maintain the Interstate Compact Adult Offender Supervision National Office website.

The Interstate Compact Adult Offender Supervision website, [www.interstatecompact.org](http://www.interstatecompact.org), shall serve as the Compact Manual of instruction or guidance.

Procedures

- A. Compact Description. The Interstate Compact on Probation and Parole provides for the transfer between member states of probationers and parolees and for their return for violations. This agreement applies to all 50 states, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, and the Virgin Islands.
- B. The Deputy Compact Administrator shall assist and train probation and parole officers within the Department in all aspects of the Compact.

The Interstate Compact Adult Offender Supervision website, [www.interstatecompact.org](http://www.interstatecompact.org), shall be reviewed by the Deputy Compact Administrator twice a year for its accuracy regarding Alaska laws and regulations.

Implementation

This policy and procedure is effective as of the date signed by the Commissioner. Each Manager shall incorporate the directions outlined in this document into local policy and procedure. All local policies and procedures must conform to these directions.
