PURPOSE:

The purpose of this Interim Policy And Procedures Memorandum (IPPM) is to clarify the circumstances in which the planning of or attempting to commit a rule infraction, or aiding or encouraging a prisoner to plan or attempt to commit a rule infraction, may be considered the same as commission of the infraction itself.

APPLICATION:

This IPPM applies to all Department employees and prisoners.

EXISTING DOC POLICY & PROCEDURES MODIFIED:

This IPPM modifies language found in DOC P&P 809.02, Prohibited Conduct and Penalties. Specifically language found in the Procedures section VII.

NEW PROCEDURES:

Procedures section VII, shall have a new section F, added as follows:

“Planning or attempting to commit or aiding or encouraging a prisoner to plan or attempt to commit an infraction described in sections B – E above, is considered the same as the commission of the infraction itself.”
