# HOW TO SCREEN DEFENDANTS FOR EM

### Type of EM Device

Screening Questions

	Alcohol Monitoring (handheld breathalyzer)	Alcohol & Curfew (ankle device)	Curfew (ankle device)	GPS (ankle device)
Do the crime and circumstances warrant <u>enhanced</u> supervision?	Yes	Yes	Yes	Yes
Does the defendant live within the city limits where PED offers EM?	Yes	Yes	Yes	Yes
Does the defendant have a stable residence?	Yes or No	Yes	Yes	Yes or No
Does the defendant have reliable access to a power source?	Yes	Yes	Yes	Yes
If an EM device in the corresponding column is ordered, additional information is needed as part of the Court order.	Times Per Day	Curfew Hours	Curfew Hours	Inclusion Zone <u>OR</u> Exclusion Zone <u>And/OR</u> Curfew Hours

\*To order Electronic Monitoring by PED, the answer to each question in the column should match the requirements for the EM device as outlined in the box. If all the answers in a column match this matrix, and the PED officer has recommended EM, then a release condition that includes EM may be appropriate.
